ABSTRACT

The research entitled “Students’ Errors in Constructing Passive Voice” is aimed to identify the students’ errors and find out the causes why the students make such errors. It is conducted to the students who are writing first chapter of *skripsi* at English Education Study Program Faculty of Teachers Training and Educational Sciences of Pakuan University. Descriptive method is used to conduct the research. The writer uses purposive sampling by taking the students who are writing first chapter of *Skripsi*.
